## PORT INFORMATION

### PORTLAND

Portland is on the south coast of England about 90 miles west of Portsmouth. The town itself is on an island which is connected by a long pebble beach, Chesil Beach, and a causeway. The well protected harbour is surrounded by the main land, causeway, island and a large breakwater. There is a small dockyard at Portland which is used by the local training squadron and ships doing work-ups under the supervision of the Flag Officer Sea Training.

Adjacent to Portland on the mainland are the towns of Wyke Reges and Weymouth. The largest of the three being Weymouth with Wyke Regis being mainly a dormitory town for the others. During the summer months Weymouth is a tourist and vacation town.

TAXIS - are available outside the main gate of the dockyard.

Buses to Weymouth run about every half hour. Cost is about 25¢. It takes approximately 20 minutes to reach there.

Sick Bay and Dental services are available in the dockyard. There is a General Hospital at Weymouth.
