

IN THE POLICE COURT

IN THE MATTER OF THE INQUIRY
INTO THE DEATH OF C.P.O. JAMES LAMBERT
AND C.P.O. FRANK ALLEN.

DECISION

Chief Petty Officer Frank Allen and Chief Petty Officer James Lambert of the Royal Canadian Navy were drowned on the early morning of June 4th, 1947 at H.M.C. Dockyard. They had been occupants of a United Taxi, operated by one Earl Sears, 212 Gotttingen St., which ran over the side of what is known as Jetty #3 at the Dockyard and into the waters of Halifax Harbour, resulting in the death of the two men above described.

It appears that the two deceased were members of the crew of H.M.C.S. Warrior which was docked along the east wall of Jetties #2 and #3. A block plan of H.M.C. Dockyard at Halifax has been tendered before me. Between Jetty #2 and Jetty #3 there is a camber of considerable width, and with the Warrior docked as above described, the camber became an enclosed pool, surrounded by the side of the ship, the two sides of the jetties mentioned and the shore side.

The taxi in question picked up the two deceased and was instructed to drive them to the Warrior. The gangplanks from the Warrior extended from the ship to Jetty #2. There were two of them in number, and at all times pertaining to this inquiry, were illuminated by electric lights. The car in question, in which the two deceased met their deaths, came in the north gate of the Dockyard, proceeded down the roadway to approximately opposite what is known as the Administration Building, and instead of proceeding directly down that roadway and around the Stores Building and the Machine Shop to Jetty #2, it proceeded down between what is known as the Utility Building and the Generator House and the Boiler and Plate Shop and on to the west end of Jetty #3, coming down in such a manner at the extreme south eastern part of this roadway to be directly in line with the lighted gangways, but these, in turn, would be across Jetty #2 with the camber in between.

This roadway is a restricted roadway and is for traffic going northwest, only. The taxi, therefore, was proceeding in a southeasterly direction, going the wrong way on a one way roadway. The entire evidence discloses that the night was very bad. There was a heavy downpour of rain, visibility was very bad. The roadways referred to in the Dockyard are asphalt and black in color when wet. In proceeding down this roadway, it is quite conceivable to anyone unfamiliar with the location and on a night such as this, with the visibility as poor as described, to assume that the passageway ran directly across to the lighted gangways. This is what the taxi driver assumed, and according to his testimony, when the car drove over the edge of the side of Jetty #3 was his first indication that the roadway didn't proceed directly to the gangways. He further testified that he was not familiar with the Dockyard and that he drove down this passageway under the direction of the Petty Officer who was sitting in the front seat with him.

The water was considerably deep, but the driver managed to extricate himself from the submerged car, subsequently came to the surface, swam, under directions, to a stairway, and was helped ashore and subsequently treated in the Sick Bay of the Warrior. On being rescued he notified Naval personnel that two others were in the car with him, and while it is not necessary here to disclose in detail all that transpired, everything was done that could be done to extricate the men as quickly as possible, and on being brought to the surface they were both pronounced dead from drowning.

The car was subsequently raised to the surface and was found to have been resting on its top on the bottom of the harbour. Lambert's body was found half out the front door of the taxi and the body of Allen was found under the rear cushion and back seat on the roof of the car when it was raised to the surface in its upturned position.

The evidence disclosed that everything possible was done to effect the rescue under all the prevailing circumstances at

the time. I am obliged, therefore, to conclude on the evidence taken before me there is no evidence of culpable negligence on the part of any person in the death of these two Naval personnel nor was their death occasioned by the unlawful act of any person or persons.
