MEMORANDUM:

I wish to commend Lieutenant (S) P.J. Sharp, R.C.N.V.R., O-66190, who has been serving the Board of Inquiry convened in H.M.C.S. "STADACONA" to investigate the nature and extent of naval participation in the recent disturbances in Halifax.
